


Jesus' new community takes shape, further rejection Mark 3:20-21; 31-35

B. A crowd/Jesus and his disciples/Jesus' family: ²⁰Then he went home, and the crowd gathered again, so that they could not even eat. ²¹And when his family heard it, they went out to seize him, for they were saying, "He is out of his mind."

B¹. Jesus' family/a crowd/Jesus and his disciples:

a) **Mother/siblings - outside calling:** ³¹And his mother and his brothers came, and standing outside they sent to him and called him.

b) **sitting around him:** ³²And a crowd was sitting around him,

a¹) **Mother/siblings - outside seeking:** and they said to him, "Your mother and your brothers are outside, seeking you."

a) **Who - mother/siblings:** ³³And he answered them, "Who are my mother and my brothers?"

b) **sat around him:** ³⁴And looking about at those who sat around him,

a¹) **Mother/siblings - whoever:** he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers! ³⁵Whoever does the will of God, he is my brother and sister and mother."
