

Jesus subdues the storm: Mark 4:37-41

A. A great storm - wind and sea: ³⁷And a great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking into the boat, so that the boat was already filling.

B. The disciples rebuke Jesus: ³⁸But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion. And they woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?"

C. A great calm:

a) **Jesus speaks to the wind and sea:** ³⁹And he awoke and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Peace! Be still!"

a)¹. **The wind and sea obey him:** And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

B¹. Jesus rebukes the disciples: ⁴⁰He said to them, "Why are you so afraid? Have you still no faith?"

A¹. A great awe - wind and sea: ⁴¹And they were filled with great fear and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even wind and sea obey him?"
